The Badlands of Western North Dakota offer opportunities for Antelope, Whitetail Deer, Mule Deer, Waterfowl, Upland Birds and varmints. Our outfitter manages over 175,000 acres of ranch land in this state of opportunity. North Dakota is becoming recognized as a sleeper state for trophy deer. Archery hunts are this outfitter's specialty. Mossy Oak has videoed at this location for both their TV show and video series. Spot & Stalk, tree stands, ground and pit blinds are the methods used for whitetail & mule deer as well as antelope. Every year several bucks make P&Y minimum. Occasional Rifle hunts for whitetail and mule deer are available. Hunting is conducted around watering holes, river bottoms and alfalfa feeds.
